We've played around with a risk map for the group in various forms over the last few months, and out of that has come our **safe airspace** initiative (together with The Airline Cooperative).

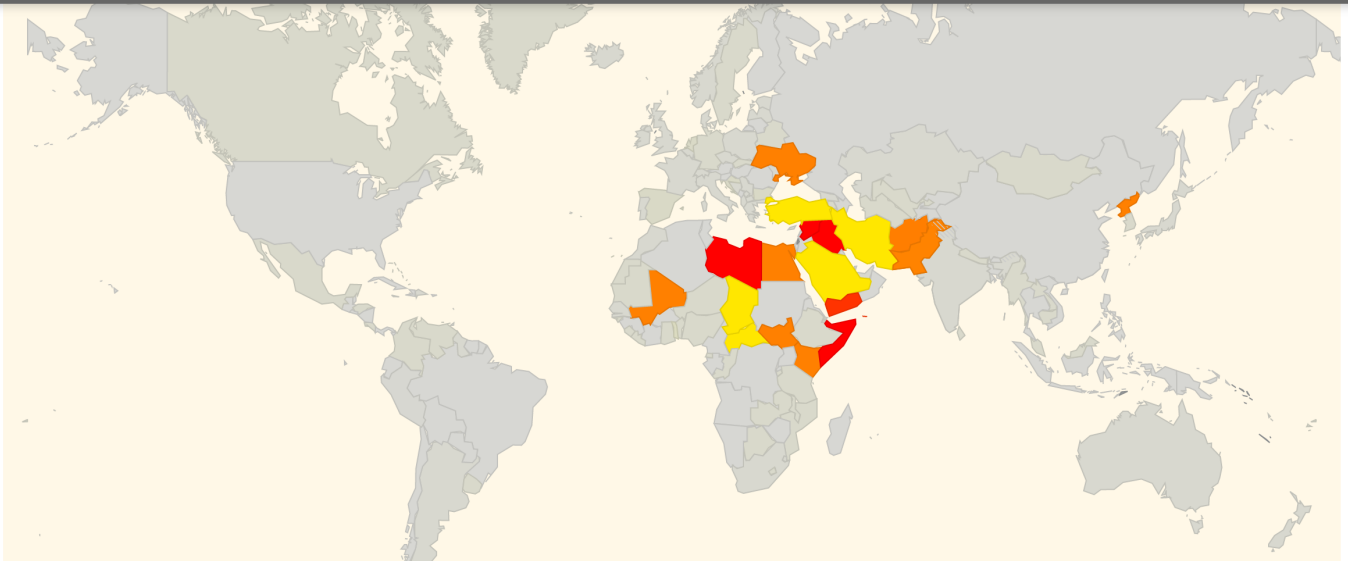
