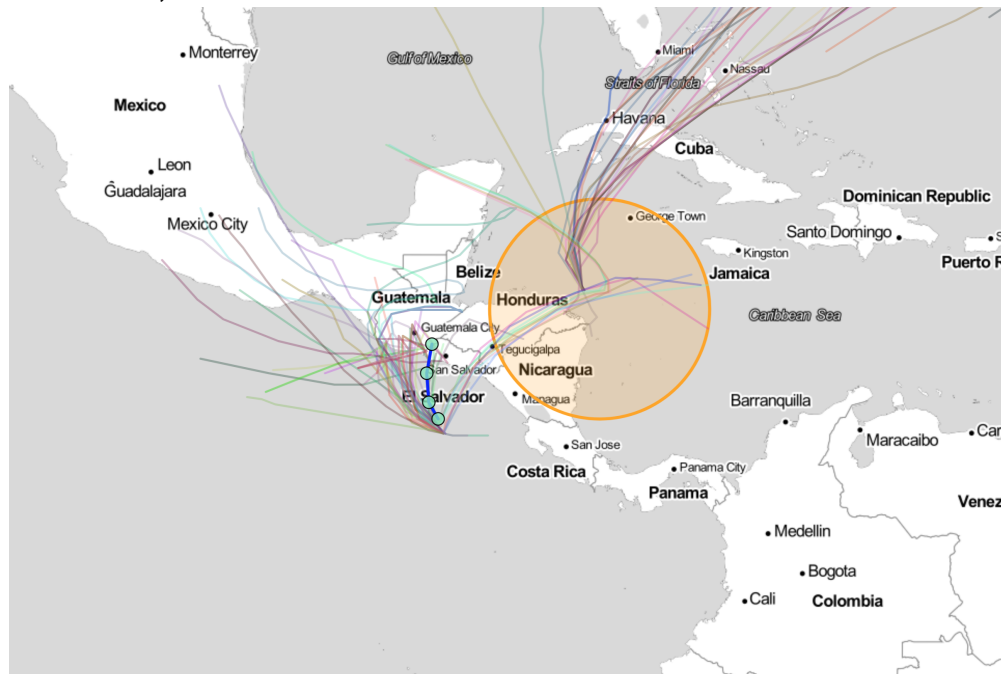


Storm: Central America landfall of Selma on Saturday

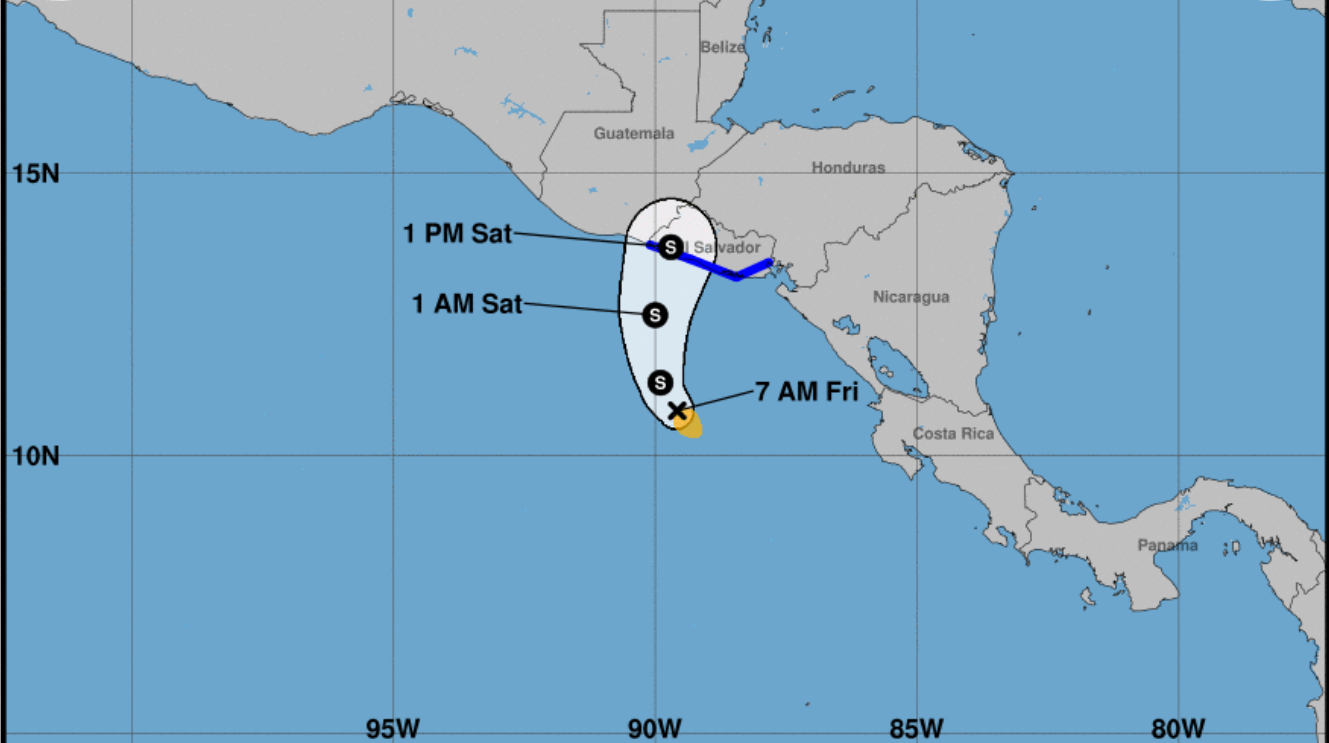
Tropical Storm Selma is heading for Central America, landfall El Salvador coast on Saturday, current winds 35G45 kts.
