

## Farnborough Airshow 2022

Farnborough Airport will continue to operate over the period of Farnborough International Airshow 2022.

In order to accommodate the Flying Display and its associated Validation Flights, restrictions will have to take place as follows: (all times GMT (Z))

Arrival/Validation Week - Monday 11th July to Friday 15th July

Possible short delays 0700 - 1800Z

Standby Day - Saturday 16th July

Possible short delays 0700 - 1600z
