USYCAA STRIKE NOTICE LIFTED

Considering the firm commitment and direct involvement of the highest authorities of the various member states of ASECNA,

Considering the relevance of the resolutions resulting from the Extraordinary Meeting of the Committee of Ministers of ASECNA, held on Monday October 17, 2022 in Dakar in the Senegalese Republic,

Considering the magnitude of the impact of the specter of the strike on the economy of our states and the activities of air users,

Considering the preponderant place occupied by the profession of Air Traffic Controller and the eminently important role incumbent on Air Traffic Controllers in the stability of the economy of States and the activities of air users,

The Executive Bureau (BEU) of the Union of Air Traffic Controllers Unions of ASECNA (USYCAA):

Expresses its deep gratitude to the members of the ASECNA Committee of Ministers who, despite the difficult context that prevailed, were able to win back the confidence of the Air Traffic Controllers through the courageous decisions they took with the aim of ensuring the sustainability of the Agency,

Congratulates all the Air Traffic Controllers of all the ASECNA control centers for their historic mobilization and their unflinching commitment to the defense of their rights and the restoration of the prestige of their noble profession,

Decides that the strike notice reactivated on Tuesday September 20, 2022 and suspended on Saturday September 24, 2022, is lifted as of Thursday October 20, 2022,

Specifies that this lifting is granted by the Air Traffic Controllers of ASECNA in order to contribute to restoring a serene social climate favorable to a constructive dialogue with a view to satisfying its protest platform.
