## **FROM SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 24, 2022**

### **USYCAA STRIKE SUSPENSION**

**Considering** the personal involvement of His Excellency Mr. Patrick Achi, Prime Minister, on the instruction of **His Excellency Mr.**

**Alassane OUATTARA**, President of the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire, who made the firm promise to bring the concerns of Air Traffic Controllers to the appropriate level,

**Considering** the negotiation session between the Executive Secretary General of USYCAA, the Minister of Transport of Senegal and the Director General of ASECNA, and the resulting conclusions, as well as the commitment of certain authorities of the various member countries of ASECNA.

**Considering** the extent of the impact of the current strike movement on the economy of our States and the activities of air users confused by misleading statements,

**Given** the level of responsibility that has always characterized the body of air traffic controllers,

The Executive Bureau (BEU) of the Union of Air Traffic Controllers' Unions of ASECNA (USYCAA)

**Welcomes** the historic mobilization of Air Traffic Controllers in all centers control of ASECNA for the defense of their interests and the rehabilitation prestige and nobility of their profession.

**DECIDED :**

- The strike notice, reactivated on September 20, 2022, is suspended for a period of ten (10) days from this day Saturday, September 24 2022.
- Air traffic services will be provided in all areas  
airspace and airports managed by ASECNA as of today  
Saturday September 24, 2022 at 12:00 UT.

This new suspension is granted by the air traffic controllers of ASECNA to once again give a chance to dialogue with a view to satisfaction of their claim platform in eight (8) points.
