GUIDELINES FOR PILOTS

IMMEDIATE ACTIONS AFTER AN INCIDENT/ACCIDENT

	Finish – complete your tasks.
	Ask – for medical help if required.
	Arrange – crew care.
	Contact – your employer, your pilot association or the IFALPA emergency number +44 1202 653 110.
	Then follow the advice below if arrested or detained:
	Comply - don't resist police or authorities. Ask why you have been detained.
	Request – ask to speak to a lawyer.
	Speak – if compelled to make a statement, use the safety phrase below:
