Inspection services for the entrance/arrival of aircraft at Albuquerque International Sunport are available M-F, 0930-1600 in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Albuquerque International Sunport (KABQ) is designated as a "landing rights airport" [19 CFR 122.1(f);19 CFR 122.14].

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from foreign and at least one business day in advance of the anticipated arrival time at KABQ. Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those parameters, you must contact CBP to resecure permission to land.



Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park at the designated FBO (Cutter Aviation or Atlantic Aviation).
- There are no general aviation inspection facilities at this location.
- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin the inspection.
- All crew and passengers will be processed planeside.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal (if appropriate). Baggage should also be readily available for inspection.
- Regulated waste/garbage will be collected by CBP from the aircraft crew.



Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- The port is closed for the following federal holiday observances: New Years, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas. We are open all other holidays.
- The Port of Albuquerque has limited staffing and other mission critical tasks beyond clearance of aircraft.
