Permission to Land Procedures

Brownsville/South Padre Island International
Airport (KBRO) is designated as an "international airport" or
"airport of entry" [19 CFR 122.1(m);19 CFR 122.15].



Pilots must contact CBP prior to departure from the foreign airport
and at least one hour in advance of the anticipated arrival time to
secure permission to land at Brownsville/South Padre Island
International Airport. Permission to land is granted with a
tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those
parameters, you must contact CBP to resecure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park on the ramp at the FIS.
- The aircraft control tower can direct you in if needed.
- The FIS is not attached to the FBO.
- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin the inspection.
- All crew and passengers will be processed inside the FIS.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- Regulated waste/garbage will be collected by CBP from the aircraft crew.
- Passengers can depart directly from FIS when the inspection process has concluded.



Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP during regular office hours.
- Any aircraft granted outbound clearance must notify CBP directly, at the phone numbers listed above, if the approved date/time of departure changes.
- Advise CBP if transporting live animals, weapons, hunting trophies, or commercial imports.
