### Permission to Land Procedures

Miami Executive Airport is designated as a  
“landing rights airport” [19 CFR 122.1(f);19 CFR 122.14].

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP no less  
than one hour but no more than 24 hours in advance of the  
anticipated arrival time at KTMB. Permission to land is granted  
with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates  
outside those parameters, you must contact CBP to resecure  
permission to land.



### Inspection Process

- All aircraft must land (block) at the CBP ramp unless authorized to block at another location by the airport control tower.
- The aircraft operator must open all crew, passenger, and cargo compartments in the aircraft for inspection by CBP.
- Inspection of the aircraft on the ramp and supervision of the unloading of baggage, disposal of regulated waste/garbage, etc., will be conducted by a CBP Officer.
- All crew and passengers with all personal belongings and baggage will be directed to and processed inside the FIS. The FIS is not attached to the FBO or main terminal.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- Passengers can depart directly from FIS at the conclusion of their inspection.



### Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- Flights arriving at Miami Executive Airport (Tamiami) within one hour or less of closing-time may be diverted to another international airport with CBP Supervisory approval.
- CBP may grant authorization for arrivals after closing hours.
- Request for permission to land and/or advance notice of arrival or any updates for Tamiami after hours can be directed to Miami General Aviation Center (305) 526-7155.
