# FOREIGN PROCEDURES REVIEW CHECKLIST

(SOURCE DOC: FAA AC 120-105B)



#### VALIDITY OF SOURCE

- o Procedure comes from an official state source (e.g. ICAO AIP).
- o Chart includes effective date and revision number.
- o Country of origin is ICAO-compliant.



### **NAVIGATION DATA CHECK**

- o All navaids (VOR, NDB etc) are correctly labeled and positioned.
- o Waypoints, fixes, and intersections accurate.
- o Transition routes properly depicted.

# FLIGHT PATH REVIEW

- o Turns and paths are flyable with standard aircraft performance.
- o Altitudes and speed restrictions are clearly marked.
- o Sequence of steps (legs) is logical and achievable.
- o Procedure ends at a valid final fix or runway.



# **⚠ OBSTACLE & TERRAIN CLEARANCE**

- o All minimum altitudes ensure safe obstacle clearance.
- o Any special terrain notes clearly shown.
- Procedure avoids known obstacles.



# **CHART LEGIBILITY**

- o Symbology is clear and follows standard ICAO format.
- o Notes, cautions, and procedure instructions are readable.
- o No clutter or ambiguous text.



#### PILOT USABILITY

- o Fits into crew workflow and normal procedures.
- o Any non-standard elements are documented in manuals.
- o Cree briefings and training materials updated as needed.



#### **DOCUMENTATION**

- o Procedure review is recorded and retained.
- o Procedure approved as per company policy
- o If applicable, integrated into the company's Flight Ops Manual

### BEFORE FLIGHT

- o Crew briefed on special considerations.
- o Procedure present in chart packs or FMS database.
- o Any conditions (e.g. Day VMC only) are in place.
- o No local state approval required.
