



Dear Valued Customer

We have received the following information from London Luton Airport (LLA) and wanted to share this news with you.

Noise restriction measures commencing Summer 2026 1st June to 30th September 2300L to 0659L

UPDATE: Signature Aviation have been allocated 6 night-movement slots per month for use throughout this period.

Only aircraft with a QC value of 0.5 or less will be allowed to operate during the night period. Only Signature Aviation Luton can request your night slot due to the process we have to follow from London Luton Airport. We can only request your slot during Monday to Friday 0900L to 1630L as these requests need to be manually approved by London Luton Airport and the slot coordinator therefore last-minute bookings will not be possible.

Please note that medical flights with a NACA 4 rating or higher will be exempt and will not be included in our 6 movements. These flights should be booked in as per our medical flight bookings process with our Guest Experience Operations Team will guide you through.

Aircraft emergencies and divers to extenuating circumstances shall be permitted but these will be logged by London Luton Airport as to the reason why.

London Luton Airport will continue to monitor the noise contours throughout the period, and should they see excessive delays into the night period by schedule movements (airline traffic), then they may need to remove our allocation of 6 slots per month to stay compliant

Aircraft operators should make every effort to reduce their QC usage where possible, especially during the night period.



Key customer questions answered by Signature Aviation Luton

What happens if my flight runs late or early – will there be any action taken by ACL or LLA?

Unless your flight is affected by an ATC CTOT restriction, you will need to keep to your booked arrival/departure slot time. Please note that these times are on/off blocks times. ACL and London Luton Airport will be closely monitoring the arrival and departure times around this night time ad-hoc slot ban period. If a flight arrives later than 2200Z or if it arrives earlier than 0559Z then ACL & London Luton Airport may class this as a slot infringement which will be investigated. For frequent events ACL & London Luton Airport may take sanctions against the operator.

What alternative airport options do I have?

If it is not possible to schedule your flight before or after this nighttime ad-hoc slot ban, then other alternative Signature Aviation locations are:
