Please note there is an **exception for the following persons who do NOT have to provide the results of a Covid test, whatever their country of provenance is**  
 → Crew members operating passenger or cargo flight (excepted French domestic flights)  
 → Members of diplomatic corps, consular staff, or international organization staff with headquarters or offices located in France as well as those spouse and children.  
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
