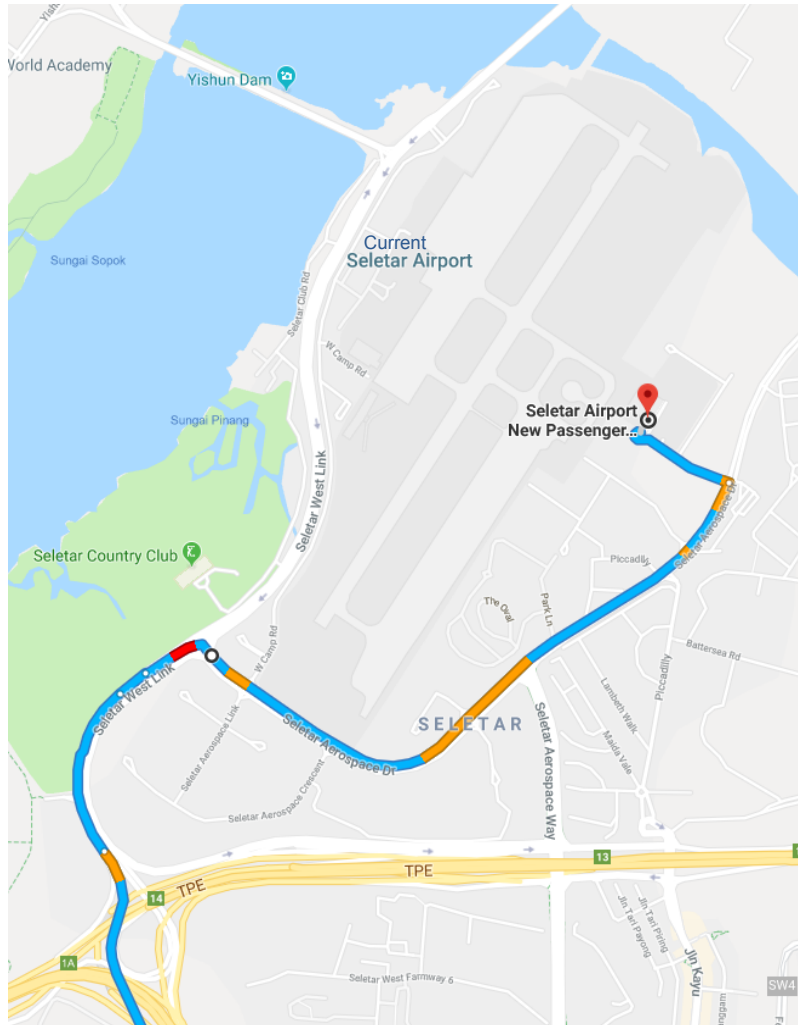
BUSINESS AVIATION/GENERAL AVIATION OPERATIONS TO COMMENCE AT THE NEW SELETAR AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING FROM 19 NOVEMBER 2018 0000H (Local Time)

Terminal operations for Business Aviation and General Aviation (BA/GA) will commence at the new Seletar Airport terminal building[1] at 21 Seletar Aerospace Road 1, Singapore 797405, with effect from 19 November 2018 0000h (LT). All related terminal operations from the current terminal building at Building 556, West Camp Road, Singapore 797794 will cease with effect from 18 November 2018 2359h (LT).

LOCATION OF SBAC



All related terminal operations from the current terminal building at Building 556, West Camp Road, Singapore 797794 will cease with effect from 18 November 2018 2359h (LT).

Business Aviation customers are hosted at the waiting lounge, designed to provide a relaxed atmosphere and comfort, before their flights. At the waiting lounge, light refreshments are served to our customers. Fast Wi-Fi access, newspapers and periodicals, and TVs showing major international channels are also available.

There will be a separate channel for General Aviation customers travelling through the SBAC to facilitate faster security and customs clearance. Business Aviation customers' baggage will be routed through the General Aviation channel.

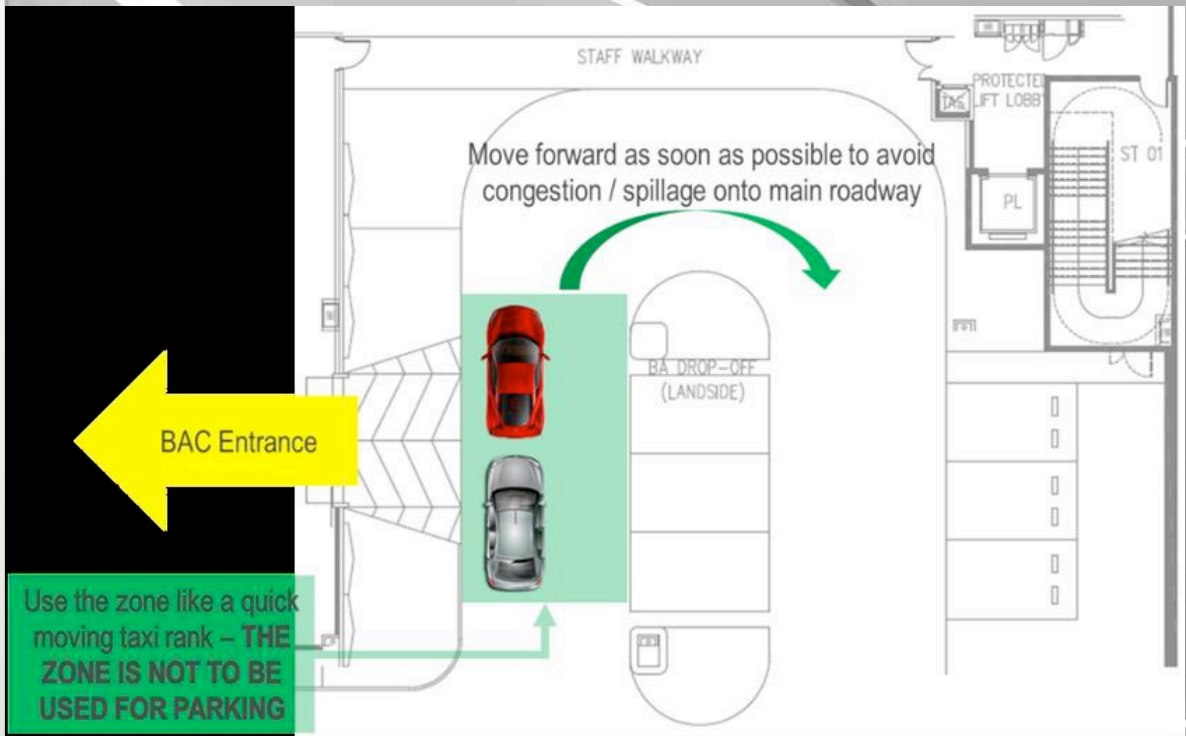
Curbside Pick-Up/Drop-Off (Landside Access)

There is a designated pick-up/drop-off area located outside the SBAC entrance.

Drivers are permitted to stop momentarily along the curb outside the SBAC entrance to drop-off passengers.

There are also complimentary spots available inside the turning circle that are limited to a maximum 15-minute wait time for vehicles ready to pick-up an arriving passenger or drop-off passengers.

If the transportation is early or the passenger is delayed, vehicles who have exceeded the waiting time will be requested to move their vehicles accordingly.



For safety and security reasons, all vehicles must not be left unattended. Drivers must remain within the SBAC facility to move the vehicle when requested by GRO or SATS APO.

This is to prevent traffic congestion and spillage onto the roadway leading to SBAC and the main passenger terminal. Similarly, there is a designated pick-up/drop-off area on airside (restricted area), just outside the SBAC exit.
